2011-2012 MFSC REGISTRATION CATEGORIES

Regular member – MFSC Home Club member with full Club privileges: Ice Show, Club Competition, member rates for MFSC-hosted skater development sessions, participation in Club socials, and voting rights. Regular member who wishes to test on Club test days must skate a minimum of 2 sessions per week. For membership fundraising and volunteer hour commitments, refer to [2011-2012 MFSC Membership Commitments](#).

Associate member – non MFSC Home Club member with no limit to number of sessions skated per week. Associate member is not eligible to participate in MFSC Club Competition; is eligible to participate in MFSC Ice Show, [group number(s) only]; eligible to participate in MFSC hosted skater development sessions at “member” rates, and in Club socials. Associate member is not eligible to test unless they have permission from their Home Club in accordance with Skate Canada rules for testing out-of-club. Guest member – non MFSC Home Club member limited to skating one session per week with MFSC. Guest member is not eligible to test unless they have permission from their Home Club in accordance with Skate Canada rules for testing out-of-club. Guest member is not eligible to participate in Ice Show, Club Competition or Club socials. Participation in MFSC-hosted skater development sessions will be at “non-member” rates. This type of registration does not include membership in the Corporation or voting rights. No fundraising or volunteer hour commitments.

Sustaining member – If a skater has been with the Club in prior years and is unable to skate with the Club because of attendance at College or University in another city, the skater may request a sustaining membership. This allows them to maintain their affiliation with the Club, guest skate when in town and to register in future years as a returning member. A letter from the skater is required explaining his/her absence, history with the Club, Skate Canada Number and a \$83.00 cheque, representing the \$50.00 sustaining membership fee plus the \$33.00 Skate Canada fee. No fundraising or volunteer hour commitments.

Partnering member– non Home Club member that partners club members for the purpose of dance tests. A fee of \$50.00 plus the \$33.00 Skate Canada fee applies. No fundraising or volunteer hour commitments.
