2011-2012 Bingo Date Request Form

Each Junior, Intermediate, and Senior skater in the club, or their Parent/Guardian, if the skater is under the age of 16 years, will be required to attend a specified number of bingo sessions during the season. Our club receives a great deal of revenue from our participation in the Bingo program and this enables us to keep our registration and session fees at a very competitive level.

For each Junior, Intermediate, Senior skater, a total of two (2) bingo sessions must be scheduled and attended during the period of September 2011 to August 2012. Where there are two or more skaters, the maximum family commitment is four (4) bingos.

It is the responsibility of the skater (or Parent/Guardian if the skater is under the age of 16 years) to contact the Club’s Bingo Co-coordinator, Shelly Ellis at 905-896-9832 to book the required number of bingo sessions. This MUST be done prior to completing your registration (either manually or on-line) to the Club.

No messages regarding bingo should be left on Club Line as we cannot ensure they get to Shelly.

Should it be necessary to change a bingo date, you must notify Shelly a minimum of 48 hours prior to the date; otherwise you will be charged the \$150.00 fee for non-attendance. Shelly needs to replace you at the Bingo. The non-attendance fee is due immediately and could result in suspension of skating privileges until payment to the club has been made.

In addition to this bingo commitment, an additional five volunteer hours are required in other areas such as helping out at fundraising events, competitions and test days etc.
