



Test Guidelines and Fees

When your coach decides that you are ready to try a test, they will submit your name and the test(s) being tried to the Club Test Chair. A list of all tests being tried will be posted on the Club Bulletin Board or at the entrance to the rink, at least 1 week prior to the scheduled test day.

Skating Tests are evaluated by a Skate Canada certified evaluator (judge). At times, Test Days do run ahead of schedule. It is best if you arrive 45 minutes ahead of your posted test time, to avoid missing your test.

When you arrive, check in with the Test Chair, or designate. You will need to provide payment for your test upon arrival. This includes the posted fee per test tried, plus the hospitality fee, which is used towards Test Day expenses. Please note that Evaluators / Judges are volunteers who give freely of their time with no monetary recompense.

A skater failing to show up on Test Day will be charged as if the test was taken, and will be listed as a "Retry" unless a medical certificate is submitted to the Test Chair within three days of the Test Day.

MFSC members must be registered for at least 2 sessions per week in order to test. Only those skaters in good standing, will be allowed to try tests.

FEES (MFSC Members)

1. SKATE CANADA TEST FEE - \$10.00 per each test tried
2. MFSC HOSPITALITY FEE - \$8.00 per test day (regardless of number of tests tried)

FEES (MFSC Non-Members)

Note: Non-MFSC members must submit a completed "Permission to Test Out-of-Club" form from their home club, prior to trying a test and will be charged an administrative fee.

1. SKATE CANADA TEST FEE - \$10.00 per each test tried
2. MFSC HOSPITALITY FEE - \$8.00 per test day (regardless of number of tests tried)
3. ADMINISTRATIVE FEE - \$15.00, per test day (regardless of number of tests tried)
