MFSC Pre-Junior Program Overview:

- ◆ This Program is designed for skaters that have completed CanSkate Stage 4 and are working on completing their CanSkate Stage 5 or 6.
- ◆ Registering in Pre-Junior skating sessions gives skaters an opportunity to experience training in a STARskate type environment, and helps them be better prepared for it when they pass CanSkate Stage 6 and become STARskaters.
- ◆ Registering in this session is optional; CanSkaters that have passed their CanSkate Stage 4 can continue registering in CanSkate sessions where they can continue working on their CanSkate Stage 5 and 6.
- ◆ The training in this program consists of off-ice and on-ice portions. Pre-Junior Sessions Schedule:
 - ◇ Thursdays Off-Ice from 6:05 pm to 6:35 pm, On-Ice from 6:50 pm to 8:05 pm
 - ◇ Saturdays Off-Ice from 11:00 am to 11:30 am, On-Ice from 11:45 am to 12:50 pm
 - ◇ Tuesdays Off-Ice from 6:05 pm to 6:35 pm, On-Ice from 6:50 pm to 8:05 pm - *NEW SESSION ADDED IN SPRING 2017*
- ◆ Pre-Junior Try-out sessions are offered on Tuesday March 7th at Iceland and Thursday March 9th at Tomken. Start time at 6:05 pm—Off-Ice Warm-up; 6:50 pm—8:05 pm On-Ice Session.

Mississauga Figure Skating Club (MFSC) offers four Learn to Skate Programs

- * Pre-CanSkate (Ages 3 to 5)
- * CanSkate (Ages 5 and older)
- * Parent and Tot (Ages 2 to 4)
- * Adult CanSkate (Ages 18 and Up)



PRE-CANSKATE is a 30 minute learn-to-skate program, especially designed for those participants who are 3-5 years of age. Lessons are in a group format and led by an Nationally Certified Professional Coach with the assistance of trained Program Assistants.

CANSKATE is Skate Canada's flagship learn-to-skate program. It teaches the fundamentals of skating in a progressive and sequential manner. Designed for beginners of all ages, the focus is on fun, participation and basic skill development.

ADULT CANSKATE is a 40 minute session that follows the same format as the CanSkate program, with the exception of badges and incentives. Lessons are in a group format and led by an Nationally Certified Professional Coach. No previous skating experience is required.

PARENT AND TOT is a 30 minute session designed so young children can experience skating for the first time in the company of a parent. The same parent must accompany the skater on the ice for each class. The parent must be able to skate forwards and backwards, and stop on the ice, and must wear a helmet at all times.

Off-Ice Fitness/Dance/Yoga offered this year for ALL MFSC STARSkaters and delivered by professional fitness instructors

- ⇒ 2 Dance/Yoga Sessions on Mondays—New Sessions
- ⇒ 2 Fitness Sessions on Fridays—New Schedule
