



Parent and Skater Roles:

The term "parent" refers to parents and guardians of skaters.

For skaters under 12 years old, a parent must be present in the arena at all times during the skater's session.

Parents and all skaters will follow the Club's <u>MSC Ice Etiquette Rules</u> or they will be asked to leave the ice rink.

The parent's name registered in the 'Member Account' is the Parent Member of MSC (provided their child has not reached the age of 18) with full voting rights at the AGM. See By-law No.1-2023 posted on the website under 'About Us'.

A registered adult skater (18 years of age and older) is an Ordinary Member of MSC with full voting rights at the AGM. See By-law No.1-2023 posted on the website under 'About Us'.

Skaters are not permitted on the ice without an MSC coach present and zamboni doors must be closed.

As per MSC's By-law No. 1-2023, memberships are not transferable.

Communications:

MSC uses its website, <u>www.mississaugafsc.com</u>, and email <u>info@mississaugafsc.com</u> to communicate important information to its members. It is the responsibility of each member to ensure that the Club has the correct email on file and to regularly check the website and their email for updates. Members may update their email subscription preferences at any time by logging into their profile under 'My Account', 'Communication Preferences' and clicking the 'Update' button. **If a member chooses to opt out of electronic communications from MSC, they acknowledge that they may not receive important communications in regards to Club activities and program information.**

Qualification as of September 1:

Club Service Hours:

Volunteering presents an opportunity for our community to come together in supporting our athletes, meeting new people, learning valuable life skills and being part of an enjoyable, team environment.

For PreJunior, a parent (for skaters under 18 yrs) or an Adult skater member (18 yrs +) must participate in the required Bingo and/or other volunteer activities within our Club or pay a buy-out of \$200.00 upon initial registration. **PreJunior members are required to complete** <u>5 credits of service commitment per skater</u> for the 2025-2026 season (max 10 credits for more than two family registrants in PreJunior; in families with skaters across both PreJunior and STARSkate, up to a maximum of 20 credits per family). Various volunteer positions will be posted on a continuing basis throughout the season on the MSC website under the 'Volunteering Tab' with a credit value attached.

Members who <u>do not complete</u> their 5 credits of volunteer commitment per skater by June 14, 2026 will be charged a pro-rated amount of \$200.00 based on credits earned to the credit/debit card on file. For any volunteer time after this date (eg summer Bingos), funds will be credited back within 2 weeks once the service is completed.

Members who volunteer for the Board of Directors positions are exempt from Bingo and member volunteer hours *only while they remain Directors*. Should a Board member resign from the Board before the end of the season, volunteer participation will be required by the member on a pro-rated basis.

Bingo Service Commitment

For the 2025-2026 season, MSC will be hosting 3 to 4 monthly Bingo sessions at Delta Bingo, Rockwood Mall, 4141 Dixie Road, Mississauga and members may choose to attend Bingos which are valued at **5 credits per session**. This is our Club's oldest fundraiser, assisting with payment of our rental ice time, in which we have participated since 1998.

There is a penalty of \$150.00 charged to the member's credit/debit card on file if they are a 'no show' for their committed date or have not given **a minimum of 24 hours' notice by email to Club Registrar with 'Attention: Bingo' in the subject line** at <u>info@mississaugafsc.com</u> as we may forfeit the Bingo session and be heavily fined by the AGCO.

Snowflake STAR 1-4 Competition Service Commitment

MSC will be hosting the *Skate Ontario Star 1-4 Event (Snowflake Competition)* January 30 – February 1, 2026 expecting approximately 1,000 skaters from across the GTA. Volunteer positions will be posted in the Fall for this exciting weekend and we will schedule a Zoom meeting with more information regarding the positions!

This event will offer a great opportunity for our STAR 1-4 level skaters to compete and showcase their skills while MSC parent members proudly support our Club.





All PreJunior parents will be required to complete <u>one volunteer shift</u> per skater to a maximum of two shifts over the 3-day weekend.

Adult PreJuniors will be required to complete <u>one volunteer shift</u> over the 3-day weekend.

There is a buyout of \$250 per shift and for each 'No Show'.

Fee Policy:

The fees for the 2025-2026 season are as follows:

Payment Policy:

Payment for the PreJunior program is by Visa Credit/Debit or Mastercard Credit/Debit in Uplifter. Upon registration, payment will default to use of any credit(s) accumulated by the skater permitting a choice to apply them or bypass to credit/debit card payment.

The annual Skate Canada fee is payable at registration covering Skate Canada membership and insurance from September 1– August 31, 2026 and forwarded to Skate Canada.

If a skater is <u>not a resident of Mississauga</u>, a non-resident fee is charged *annually* and forwarded to the City of Mississauga as per their policy.

The Skate Ontario Lottery Booklet is the main fundraiser for MSC and will be physically distributed following Fall and Winter registrations at the CanSkate table subsequent to email notification to the membership.

The first installment must be paid at the time of registration. This will include the Skate Canada fee, Club administration fee, non-resident fee (if applicable), Skate Ontario Lottery Booklet, volunteer buy-out fee (if applicable), STAR 1-4 Snowflake Event buy-out (if applicable) and 20% of program fees.





Four installment payments for the balance of the program fees will be charged to the credit/debit card on file on November 15, 2025 (20%), January 15, 2026 (20%), March 15, 2026 and May 15, 2026 (20%).

Pro-rating of session fees begins immediately after the PreJunior session start dates.

It is the responsibility of the member to ensure that the credit/debit card on record for installment payments is valid, as a processing fee will be charged for declined transactions. *In order to update credit/debit card information, please email request to Club Registrar at info@mississaugafsc.com*

A skater may not step onto the ice if their account is in arrears.

Refund and Credit Policy:

Please email request to Club Registrar at <u>info@mississaugafsc.com</u> and allow up to 2 weeks for processing:

Up to 48 hours before sessions commence: Refund consists of repayment of session fee(s) plus SkateCanada fee, non-resident fee (if applicable) and Skate Ontario Lottery Booklet, less the administration fee and withdrawal fee. Refunds will be issued onto the credit/debit card used to complete the initial transaction.

Up to the withdrawal deadline: Refund will be given for prorated session fee(s) and the volunteer buyout fee (if applicable), less Skate Canada fee, less non-resident fee (if applicable), less the Skate Ontario Lottery Booklet, less administration fee and withdrawal fee. Prorated session fee(s) will be calculated from the date of the written (emailed) notice. Refund is not provided for unattended classes or classes occurring before your registration start date. Refunds will be issued onto the credit/debit card used to complete the initial transaction.

<u>After the withdrawal deadline:</u> Credit only will be given for prorated session fee(s) and prorated volunteer buy-out fee (if applicable), less Skate Canada fee, less non-resident fee (if applicable), less Skate Ontario Lottery Booklet, less administration fee and withdrawal fee. Prorated session fee(s) will be calculated from the date of the written (emailed) notice. Credit is not provided for unattended classes or classes occurring before your registration start date. **NO Refunds**.

Credits will be posted to the member's MSC account and may be used for any family member residing at the same physical address within one year of the issue date of the credit.





Adding/ Changing A Session:

If you wish to **add** a session, fees for the added session must be paid before the skater can participate in the program. The session may be added by registering online and is available only if space permits on that session.

If you wish to **change** a session after registration, the difference in program fees plus a session change fee must be paid before the skater can switch sessions as space permits.

Missed Sessions:

A skater CANNOT attend a different session on a different day or at a different time to makeup for a missed session.

NO refunds or credits will be issued for missed sessions.

Helmets:

CSA approved hockey helmets are mandatory for all PreJuniors until completion of CanSkate Stage 5. Skaters attending a Club family skate must wear a CSA approved hockey helmet if they have not passed CanSkate Stage 5. Skaters not abiding by these rules will be asked to leave the ice by a Coach.

Ice Changes

The Club reserves the right to:

- Change rinks and times of sessions as necessary when requested by the City of Mississauga.
- Cancel a program due to insufficient enrollment.
- Limit number of skaters on each session.
- Cancel a session due to severe weather or other circumstances beyond the control of MSC.
- Cancel a session if the City of Mississauga closes the arena facility.

NO refunds, credits or make-up classes are provided for cancelled sessions.
